



Placement Homes Needed

We need your help to provide temporary & long-term placement for our youth.

Traditionally, we have always cared for our children through extended families. It is common for relatives to care for one another's children in times of need.

Becoming a tribal foster parent is another way you can help carry on our Tulalip traditions and ensure our tribal history and values continue for future generations.

Types of Placement Needed

- Respite
 - provide up to 10 days of care
- Emergency
 - available for emergent placement
- Short-Term
 - up to 1 year
- Long-Term
 - beyond 1 year or until reunification

Applicant Requirements

- Must be 18
- Have no disqualifying crimes, as determined & defined by Tulalip Tribes
- Must have a home that can meet basic fire & safety standards
- Be sensitive to youth's connection with their community
