On-Call Consulting Engineering Services

1. Introduction

The Tulalip Tribes is seeking proposals from qualified engineering professionals or engineering firms to provide On-Call Consulting Engineering Services on an as-needed basis. The selected consultant will serve as a trusted technical advisor and provide broad-based engineering expertise to support project planning, design review, construction, infrastructure, facilities, operational initiatives, and responses to government inquiries. The intent of this engagement is to establish a professional services relationship with an individual engineer or engineering firm capable of providing timely technical guidance across a wide range of disciplines and project types.

2. Scope of Services

Responding to technical questions and requests for information; reviewing plans, specifications, reports, studies, and technical documents; assisting with project planning, feasibility evaluations, and design interpretation; participating in meetings; providing technical recommendations and independent assessments; supporting regulatory and permitting discussions; preparing technical memorandums and written recommendations; identifying risks and recommending practical solutions.

3. Desired Qualifications

Broad knowledge and experience across multiple engineering disciplines and construction-related fields. Experience supporting public sector, tribal, municipal, state, federal, or infrastructure projects. Professional Engineer registration preferred and ten or more years of relevant experience. Areas may include civil, structural, mechanical, electrical, environmental, utilities, facilities, transportation, construction management, and regulatory compliance.

4. Term of Services

One-year term with options to extend. Services provided on an on-call, as-needed basis. No minimum workload is guaranteed.

5. Proposal Requirements

Cover Letter; Qualifications; Resumes of Key Personnel; Relevant Experience; Similar Projects; Hourly Rates and Fee Schedule; Licenses and Certifications; Three References.

Relevant Experience and Qualifications (35%), Breadth of Technical Expertise (25%), Government or Tribal Experience (20%), Availability and Responsiveness (10%), Cost and Fee Structure (10%).
